5	<p>Constraints Map:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Need to refine the "special landscape areas" on the printed maps. • What are the "special/confirmed landscapes on the Mid Suffolk maps – PH to provide the map and LB and LH to investigate • LB and LH to walk the areas and make notes/photos in order to physically define the boundaries of these areas. Deemed critical information to avoid ambiguous mark-ups. • Define locations of TPOs, pollarded trees etc. • The provided flood zone classification (and numbering 1-3) is unclear and needs to be investigated. • We need a definition (and mark-up) of the meaning of "local plan visually important open spaces" as many of these will not be open to the public (e.g. allotments). Is this the parish Local Plan or MS Local Plan? • Contour data to be obtained for the map from which the transect "slice" will be derived. • DH will draw up the transect slice to be 200yds wide • We will select local views from photographs supplied by the public, as per JD request.
