General News...

Across Mid-Suffolk, we are continuing to see significant numbers of thefts from sheds and garages, many of which have been left insecure by owners. There has also been a rise in thefts from HGV's whilst parked up in laybys around Haughley/ Stowmarket area.

Warning to shoppers after purse thefts...

Shoppers are being warned to remain vigilant after purse thieves struck in three towns in the west of the county recently. Offences have occurred in Bury St Edmunds, Stowmarket and Sudbury.

Safe Rider Workshops...

Motorcyclists across Suffolk are being given the opportunity to improve their riding skills to have better awareness and ability while on the road at 'Safe Rider' motorcycle workshops. Safe Rider is a joint initiative between Suffolk and Norfolk Constabularies aimed at reducing the number of motorcycle casualties across the counties. In 2014, 30 people were killed on Suffolk's roads, 6 of which were motorcyclists. The number of rider deaths saw a decrease of 3 from 2013, when a total 25 people died on the county's roads, where 9 were motorcyclists.

The two day workshops will run from March through to September, the months when it is considered the number of motorcyclists taking to the roads increases due to more clement weather.
