It was noted that trees on plots are in breach of the tenancy rules as is non cultivation of all of the plot for vegetable, fruit or flowers. As there is now a waiting list for allotment plots there is concern that any lack of management of current usage will be criticised. It was agreed that the administration records for the Allotment Sites will in future be held by the parish clerk. Any recommendations regarding possible breaches of tenancy rules will be put to the trustees and the council at the next meeting once site visits have been carried out.
