- a. The grass has recently been cut and the park is looking nice and tidy however the area at the bottom of the park backing onto Cherry tree rise needs strimming back, myself and the team of volunteers will be evaluating any and how much work is needed to the area this coming Thursday.
- b. My self and a team of volunteers will be starting the maintenance and repair to the matting of the second swing set this coming Thursday.
- c. I have now received & reviewed the annual play equipment inspection report. A separate report on the recommendation is to follow.
- d. I have not received any complaints this month regarding “Dog Fouling” on the park. I have walked the park during my weekly inspection and have not come across any fouling.
- e. I have walked the playfield and performed my own weekly playground equipment inspections and found no problems.
- f. In the June report, regarding the request for some football goal nets. Where I was told that to old nets have been found, so no further action was needed. However the old nets were found to be in a very poor state of repair and not serviceable. So a new set have been purchased by a member of the village for £48.00. I have been asked if the council could pay for them on behalf the village.
- g. I have also had a request for the football pitch to be marked out (white lined) if possible? Unfortunately I don’t have the expertise or the equipment to perform this task. I suggest that this along with the Nets be placed on the agenda to be discussed at the November meeting.
