Report to the Ordinary Meeting Dated 4th February 2019

Agenda Item; Councillor portfolios

- a. I have not received any complaints this month regarding “Dog Fouling” on the park. I have walked the park during my weekly inspections and have found only two incidents of dog fouling (been removed).
- b. I have walked the playfield and performed my own weekly playground equipment inspections and found no problems other than my ongoing maintenance projects.
- c. All maintenance tasks/jobs are in hand and ongoing and when finished will be included in future reports.
- d. I have received this year’s Annual play equipment report and will give a summary of it along with my recommendations at the **March** full council meeting. A brief review shows only minor problems with monitoring.
- e. During my weekly playfield walks I have noticed a growing number of MOLE hills. We now have some 20 or more and some are quite large, indicating they may be nursery mounds! (Family mole hills). As they are not on the football pitch but run along either side of the foot path they are not causing anything but a trip hazard although they are very easy to see. I will monitor the problem and report back.
