Report to the Ordinary Meeting Dated 1st July 2019

Agenda Item; Councillor portfolios

- a. I have not received any complaints this month regarding “Dog Fouling” on the park. I have walked the park during my weekly inspections and have found no incidents of dog fouling.
- b. I have walked the playfield and performed my own weekly playground equipment inspections and found no problems other than some erosion/wear to the sides of the mound slide. This is due to children using the sides of the mound rather than using the wooden steps provided. I shall monitor and report a course of action. **(No Change)**
- c. All other maintenance tasks/jobs are in hand and ongoing and when finished will be included in future reports.
- d. During my weekly playfield walks I have noticed a growing number of MOLE hills. We now have some 20 or more. As they are not on the football pitch but run along either side of the foot path they are not causing anything but a trip hazard although they are very easy to see. I will monitor the problem and report back **(No Change)**.
- e. The grass has now been cut in the last week of June, I will look into this?
- f. One third of the new boundary fencing looks to be completed and the other remaining fence appears to be under way.
