General

As of 30 Sept there are 2 open highways issues logged on the Suffolk Highways website; vis.

1. Condition of White Lines at jcn of The Street and Beyton Road. Suffolk CC status has changed from "Routine Inspection Ordered" to the works being planned, which will be completed within 14 weeks. This places completion approximately 11 Nov 2019.
2. A boundary clarification request on Cross St. Suffolk provide little other information and as nothing has been reported to the Parish Council on this matter, the Council cannot determine what the issue is here.
