1. Various pothole on Hill Farm Lane

There is also a report of flooding, Park Road, near Drinkstone Lake. No action is noted by Suffolk and I expect the urgency has now gone.

6. Beyton Road, opposite Dene Cottage TL958619 (Dene Cottage, Kimberley and Shortgate)
