

## Planning/Community Report Drinkstone

### Parish Council Ordinary Meeting 7<sup>th</sup> December 2020

#### Planning Matters

MSDC have refused the outline planning permission (application DC/20/03665) Ivy Cottage Rattlesden Road, whilst the reasons reflect the points highlighted by DPC Neighbourhood Plan it is disappointing that they failed to specifically refer to it. If we are to expect future planning applications to refer to the NP then ideally we need it to be brought to the fore by MSDC.

Planning application DC/20/05249 (prior permission DC/17/03975) Yew Tree Cottage Cross Street. Drawing (TL4466-20-10) indicates that the applicant has requested to move the replacement dwelling building on the plot, placing it further to the rear – in fact almost to the boundary. Looking at the DPC Neighbourhood Plan settlement boundary, the request to move the replacement dwelling to this site would place it outside the settlement boundary, as defined in the MSDC local plan, which whilst 20 years old has now been reviewed by the Neighbourhood Plan which has been approved by MSDC and now carries significant weight in determining planning applications.

The proposal does not comply with the Neighbourhood Plan NP DRN1 – Spatial Strategy ‘Proposals for development located outside the Settlement Boundary will only be permitted for that which is essential for the operation of agriculture, horticulture, forestry, outdoor recreation and other exceptional uses, where i) it can be satisfactorily demonstrated that there is an identified local need for the proposal’

The application fails to supply a site location plan which highlights its relation to other buildings and its position outside of the settlement boundary and within open countryside.

The original application states the retention of trees to the north west boundary, however these do not appear to have been retained, most trees have been removed. The trees that are to the north west belong to the neighbouring property and include two substantial oak trees. The roots of the oaks and subsequently their health could be affected by construction activities in the new location. The application does not include a Land Contamination report, as there has been concern from residents regarding the storage of diesel onsite in unbunded containers as well as concern regarding burning and burial of waste and lack of maintenance to existing ditches, this report is therefore more pertinent. It is understood that an enforcement visit was requested in the past based upon these concerns.

The application does not include details regarding drainage and run off will be managed.

This application should not be considered as a variation but should be a new application as it lies outside of the settlement boundary which the Parish Council would not support. Its proposed relocation would set a precedence for further development outside of the settlement boundary.

The proposed site for the replacement dwelling development is situated to the rear of Matilda House which is identified within the Neighbourhood Plan (Appendix B) as a Building of Local Significance.

Policy DRN12 of the Neighbourhood plan also states, proposals will be supported where

- h. wherever possible ensure that development faces onto existing lanes
- i. not result in water run off that would add to or create surface water flooding

NP Policy DRN10 states ‘The retention and protection of local heritage assets and buildings of local significance, including buildings, structures, features and gardens of local interest must be appropriately secured. Proposals for

any works that would lead to the loss of, or substantial harm to, a building of local significance should be supported by an appropriate analysis of the significance of the asset to enable a balanced judgement to be made having regard to the scale of any harm or loss and the significance of the heritage asset’.

DC/20/05301 Rosings Rattlesden Road This application would appear to be an infill extension and whilst it may provide an opportunity for future change of use to the garage I have no opposition to the application.

## Community Matters

I have listed below quotes for the new play equipment on The Cricket. As suggested (as I wasn't sure of the budget) I asked companies to quote for both the zip wire run and a 'Basket/nest' type cradle swing, with required safety matting, unfortunately not all quotes are split. I was particularly impressed with Playdale as they were keen to visit site, their equipment is manufactured in the UK and they have accounted for onsite requirements during the installation and split the quote as requested. Also their below surface posts are metal, above surface is wooden. With regard to installation we would need to ensure there are no hidden cables, drains etc, this can be done via [www.linsearchbeforeyoudig.co.uk](http://www.linsearchbeforeyoudig.co.uk).

Installation of both items (which I appreciate is highly unlikely) would save on welfare storage etc total  
£14840.40 + VAT

With regard to ongoing costs Playdale stated as with all equipment it would need to be included in a regular inspection but this does not need to be carried out by them. The tension may need to be adjusted following installation but this would be included in the installation price. As the equipment is robust it would not need additional specialised maintenance.

Installation time is approximately a week and the lead time is 8 weeks.

**TGF\*** **Timber Ground Fixed** - timbers are concreted into holes in the ground.

**SF\*** **Surface Fixed** - equipment is bolted directly on top of concrete.

### Foundation spoil

However, any spoil arising from the installation will be incorporated wherever possible within the construction of your play area.

**Easy access** – 30m to walk from delivery/access point OR to carry down steps/through buildings. Vehicle access of more than 10m across grass/field is considered bad access, and a cost contingency must be allowed for the reinstatement of grass.

### **Setting out/technical drawings to aid site preparation - £90 per site/play area**

If you are preparing an area for your playground prior to a Playdale installation these drawings are essential to ensure the area is prepared correctly for the equipment and safety surfacing being installed. Costs may be incurred and/or BS EN 1176 safety areas may not be met if the site fails to meet our specification.

### **Site survey to review/inspect site preparation - £260 plus any additional costs**

If you are preparing your own groundwork or the preparation of groundwork is to be undertaken by others, a site survey by Playdale will need to be carried out to ensure that the groundwork has been prepared in accordance to our specification and in line with the requirements of BS EN 1176. Should they fail to meet our specification additional costs may be incurred.

### **Site services plans**

Playdale requires as part of CDM health and safety regulations, service plans of all utilities in the area where we are installing your play area. If these plans are not received before installation a cost of £300 will be added to your invoice to cover costs incurred to Playdale to obtain information.

### **Recommended safety surfacing**

In order to comply with the safety standards, the items in your quotation may require a safety surface. We will be happy to provide a quotation upon request.

### **Wet pour**

If you are adding to, or repairing an existing wet pour surface we would advise that the new wet pour is in a contrasting colour to the existing wet pour. This is because we cannot guarantee that colours will match if the same colour is used again. Please note that the wet pour binder is subject to a very slight yellowing upon UV exposure which can cause some colours to slightly alter in appearance.

### **Making any changes**

Any changes made to your quotation may affect the overall cost. Prices quoted are assuming the site will be the same as when surveyed by Playdale, if different at the time of installation, extra costs may be incurred.

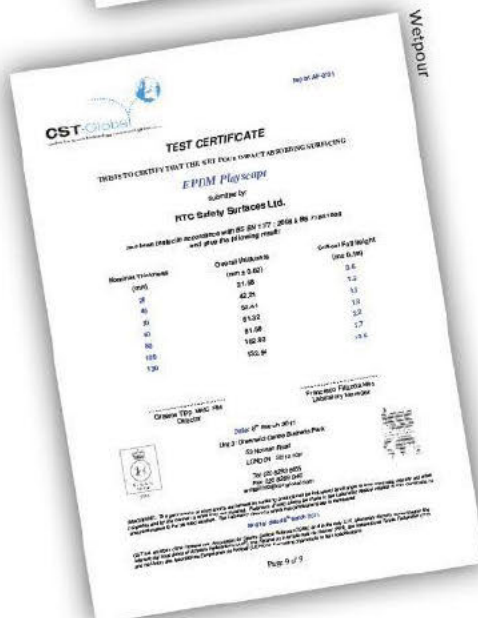

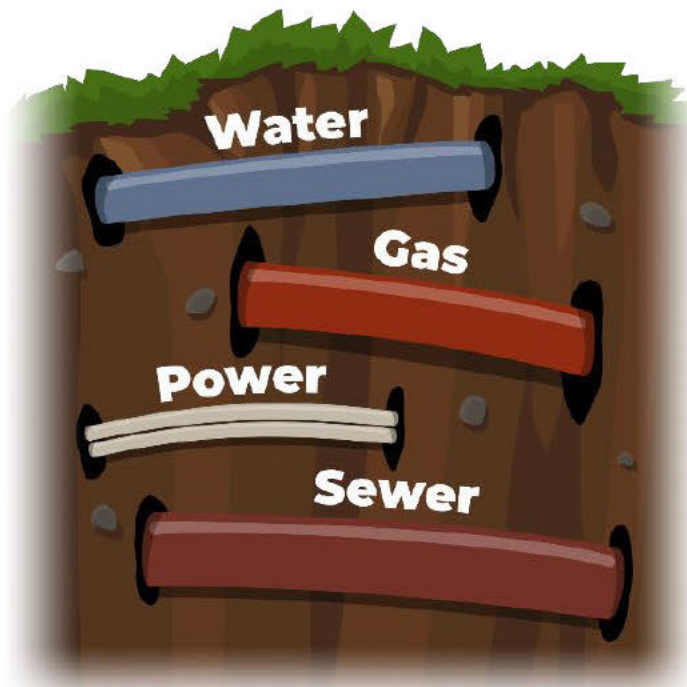

- Any damage to underground services is not only potentially life-threatening but can also cause serious service damage.
- It is imperative that plans are obtained about ALL buried services in your area before any work to the play area begins.

All raw material and bought-in components we use in the manufacture of our equipment comply with the relevant British / European or ISO Standards.

- **Timber Poles**

Machine rounded, laminated pine from managed forests. These are used throughout our 'Timber' range. All timber is pressure treated in compliance with EN 351-1 and EN 335-2. - ***Covered by a 20-year guarantee against structural failure due to rot or infestation when above ground level (i.e all horizontal and vertical timbers are installed in conjunction with Playdale's steel ground fixing brackets). Covered by 15 year guarantee against structural failure due to rot or infestation when timber poles are installed directly into the ground.\****

## 1 - General

The headings to the clauses shall not affect the construction of these conditions;  
The use of the plural shall include the singular and the use of the singular shall include the plural.
- 1.2 These conditions shall be incorporated into each and every Contract made between the Company and the Customer.
- 1.3 These conditions shall apply to the exclusion of any terms or conditions put forward by or on behalf of the customer and in the event of any conflict or inconsistency between these terms and conditions of trading and the terms of your order, these terms and conditions prevail, unless otherwise agreed by the Company in writing.
- 1.4 These conditions shall not create any agency or partnership between the Company and the Customer or any third party.
- 1.5 No person in the employment or acting otherwise as agent of the Company or purporting so to do has authority to accept Orders or supply Goods in any condition other than those contained herein or to vary these conditions in any way whatsoever. Previous dealings between the Company and the Customer shall not vary or replace these conditions or be deemed in any circumstances whatsoever so to do.
- 1.6 No purported variation or waiver of or addition to these conditions, whether written or oral or in respect of representations or statements made, shall have effect unless and until authorised in writing by a manager of the Company.
- 1.7 Quotations, whether written or oral, submitted by the Company shall be deemed to be an invitation to treat and not an offer.

## 2 - Acceptance

- 2.1 No order shall be deemed accepted by the Company unless received in writing. Only when the Company has notified the Customer of acceptance of the written order by despatch of the order acknowledgement shall the contract between the Company and the Customer be deemed to be made.
- 2.2 Any quotation issued by the Company shall be open for acceptance at any time during the validity period shown on the quotation. If unstated the validity period is 30 days. After the expiration of the validity period of the quotation the quotation is deemed to have been withdrawn by the Company.
- 2.3 Any quotation is made on the understanding that it will be accepted in full. In the event of partial acceptance of the quotation by the Customer a written revised quotation may be sent by the Company to the Customer. Any description or specification or drawing or particulars accompanying the quotations or contained in the Company's marketing material shall not form part of the Contract.
- 2.4 It is the Customers responsibility to check the order acknowledgement to ensure it is correct and notify the Company of any mistakes in writing immediately.
- 2.5 Additions or alterations to Orders, however made, shall not be binding until confirmed by the Company in writing.
- 2.6 The company reserves the right to change products, specifications or prices without prior notice.

## 3 - Prices

- 3.1 All prices quoted are net and subject to VAT at the rate ruling at date of despatch.
- 3.2 Prices will be held firm for deliveries made during the validity period of a quotation, but thereafter, or if no validity period is stated, we reserve the right to invoice at the price ruling at date of despatch.
- 3.3 Prices do not include installation costs unless stated.
- 3.4 We reserve the right to make an increased charge in the event that the completion of delivery and installation is delayed by reason of the Customer's instructions or other reason beyond the Company's control.
- 3.5 If the Customer requires alteration to the order, the price will be varied accordingly and the Company shall be entitled to recover any ancillary costs incurred.

## 4 - Title

- 4.1 Risk in the Goods shall pass on delivery.
- 4.2 Notwithstanding the foregoing the Title of Goods supplied by the Company shall not pass to the customer until payment is made in full.
- 4.3 In case of default in payment the Company shall be granted access rights in order to repossess the goods.
- 4.4 If the Customer delivers the Goods to a third party before payment has been made in full to the Company, the Customer shall hold all sums received for such goods as trustee for the Company and shall remit them to the Company on receipt.

## 5 - Delivery

- 5.1 Any date quoted for collection and delivery is an estimate only. The Company shall not be liable for any failure to meet any such estimate nor for any loss, whether financial or otherwise resulting directly or indirectly therefrom.
- 5.2 Any alterations to the order by the Customer may delay the completion of the order.
- 5.3 The Customer must examine the Goods and notify the Company of any defects or shortages within 5 days of delivery.
- 5.4 If the Customer is not available or prepared to accept delivery the Company may leave the Goods on the premises without responsibility for loss or damage to them.



## 6 - Installation

- 6.1 This clause shall apply only where the Company and Customer have agreed in writing that the contract shall include the cost of installing Goods.
- 6.2 Any date quoted for commencement or completion of installation is an estimate only. The Company shall not be liable for any failure to meet any such estimate nor for any loss, whether financial or otherwise resulting directly or indirectly therefrom. The time for completion of installation shall not be of the essence.
- 6.3 Any price quoted for installation is calculated on the basis that the site is available to start on the agreed date and that work can be carried out continuously during working hours. In the event that the start of the work is delayed or the work is disrupted by interruptions or any other cause whatsoever, or by the Customer's instructions or lack of instructions, the Company shall be entitled to charge a reasonable amount for any extra cost incurred. In addition, where the Customer delays an installation the Company reserves the right to charge storage at a rate of ½ % per week or part thereof of the price of the goods in storage.
- 6.4 Where installation has been quoted the price assumes digging in a grassed/tarmac area, but should difficulties be encountered underground in our excavations, we reserve the right to adjust our costings accordingly.
- 6.5 Should there be any alterations to the Safer Surfacing dimensions from the original quotation, the Company reserves the right to re-quote or adjust the price accordingly.
- 6.6 The Company shall notify the Customer when installation has been completed. Installation is deemed to be complete if the Goods are fit for use notwithstanding minor omissions or defects.
- 6.7 Upon notification by the Company that installation is complete, the Customer shall sign a Document provided by the Company acknowledging that the Goods have been installed in accordance with the contract. If the Customer fails to do so, provided the Goods and the installation thereof are to the reasonable satisfaction of the Company, the Document will be deemed to have been signed by the Customer.
- 6.8 The Customer shall indemnify the Company against all costs and claims arising from damage or injury to persons or property occurring during the course of installation unless such damage or injury shall be proved to have been caused solely by the negligence of the Company, its servants or agents.

## 7 - Terms of Payment

- 7.1 A 50% deposit is required with order and the full balance payment must be received by the Company prior to delivery unless special credit arrangements are agreed in writing with the Company.
- 7.2 Where special arrangements are made notwithstanding anything to the contrary therein stated no offset or retention shall be allowed and the Company in any event reserves the right to cancel such special arrangements at any time and demand payment of all outstanding sums forthwith.
- 7.3 Where credit facilities have been arranged the accounts are due for payment within the agreed number of days from the date of invoice. If no specific credit term has been agreed then the customer shall pay all sums due to the Company under the Contract within 7 days of the invoice date. Where the Contract provides for the supply of Goods only the Company's invoice will be issued on despatch of the Goods from the Company's premises. Where the Contract provides for the supply and installation of Goods the invoice will be issued on completion of the installation by the Company unless different written arrangements (such as stage payments and retentions) have been made.
- 7.4 If payment is late, interest shall accrue on all sums due and outstanding at 3% above Barclays Bank Plc base rate until the actual date of payment (both before and after any judgement).

## 8 - Consents

- 9.1 Except where expressly contained in this Contract, all warranties, conditions, undertakings and representations, express or implied, statutory or otherwise, are excluded and the Company has no obligation, duty or liability in Contract, tort (including negligence or breach of statutory duty) or otherwise.
- 9.2 In any event, the Company's liability arising for any reason in connection with this contract shall be limited to the original invoice value of goods.
- 9.3 In no circumstances will the Company be liable in Contract, tort (including negligence or breach of statutory duty) or otherwise for loss (whether direct or indirect) or profits, business or anticipated savings, or for any indirect or consequential loss or damage whatever.

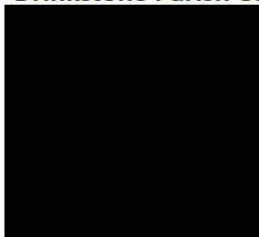

In order to comply with the safety standards, the items in your quotation may require a safety surface. We will be happy to provide a quotation upon request.

### **Wet pour**

If you are adding to, or repairing an existing wet pour surface we would advise that the new wet pour is in a contrasting colour to the existing wet pour. This is because we cannot guarantee that colours will match if the same colour is used again. Please note that the wet pour binder is subject to a very slight yellowing upon UV exposure which can cause some colours to slightly alter in appearance.

Wetpour surfacing colours can be affected by UV light at the time of installation. This will only be a temporary colour change, before the surfacing returns to its intended vibrant colour.

Tarmac surface skims are installed onto existing surfaces with the understanding that Playforce Ltd will not be held responsible for future repairs resulting from weed growth damaging the tarmac surface.

Playforce recommends the installation of kerb edging when installing wetpour surfacing onto tarmac / concrete and other hard surfaces. This type of edging detail provides a suitably firm fixing point for the surface and protects the surrounding hard surface from future cracking or failure. Chased edges can be provided but Playforce does not accept responsibility for any future repairs to the tarmac / concrete / hard surface or wetpour resulting from the expansion and contraction forces exerted by the surfacing.

Softbond mulch is frequently specified for installation onto existing grassed areas. Whilst we take care to ensure the suitability of the ground conditions at the time of specifying the product, there can be occasions when the ground beneath the softbond mulch, over a period of time, can move, causing the softbond mulch to sink. For this reason, Playforce advises the laying of an MOT Type 1 base before laying softbond mulch. Playforce therefore does not cover the costs of repairing these areas under warranty should the MOT option not be chosen.

The customer / client is reminded that it is their responsibility to ensure grassed areas are regularly cut and maintained to a height not exceeding 50mm, prior to the installation of any surfacing that may have been ordered. Failure to do so will incur costs for delays; any aborted visits or any other cost interrupting planned work.

We recommend that all existing court markings are removed before laying new line markings. Please note that removal of line markings come at an additional cost and this is not included with new line markings unless included specifically in your quotation.
