General

Nothing major to report. The footpaths are all passable and appear to be well-used. This, combined with the very limited amount of rain, has resulted in minimal overgrowth. Areas which had previously become very muddy, notably on Footpath 14, have completely dried up.

Fallen Down Sign - Footpath 6

The sign on the foot-bridge linking the two fields along Footpath 6 (opposite Chapel Lane) has fallen down. It would be a simple job to fix. Please could councillors inform me whether this has been reported to the relevant body, or alternatively if it is something the council can fix ourselves.

Stile - Footpath 16

I am aware this has already been mentioned in previous meetings, I remain concerned that it is a health and safety hazard.

Footpath Map Holders

Councillor Edmundson was contacted by Lyn Hannant with regards to replacing the plastic bags containing the footpath maps with permanent, waterproof holders. These have now been fitted around the village, and look very smart. Many thanks to all those involved in sorting these out.
