Drinkstone Parish Council owns a piece of land known as the Cricket. The Cricket houses a football pitch and a children's playground. The land has fences and hedges to three sides but one end is exposed to a road - Cross Street.

The Council would like to enclose the area with a hedgerow to offer more security for the children in the play area and to genetally improve the site.

The hedgerow would be circa 75 metres long with perhaps a gate to allow grounds maintenance access.

Planting of a hedgerow would also stop cars and traffic parking on the play area
