Allotments

MSDC approved the request for muntjac fencing for the Rattlesden Road allotments. The fencing contractor – Sapphire – has been instructed to proceed.

There has been no formal request for fencing at Gedding Road.

All allotments are let and all 2025/6 fees have been collected.

The Wayleaves agreements have been consolidated to ensure that all monies are received and the address for the account has been moved to the Clerk's address.

The bank balance for the allotments stands at circa £1,800 with a creditor of £146 due to the Parish Council for the cost of the planning application.

There seems to be an opportunity to wind up the allotment charity. I would recommend that the Allotment Trustees meet to approve its dissolution with a suggestion /recommendation on how the allotments will be managed by its allotment holders.

Annual parish meeting

This meeting will be held on Wednesday June 11th. Can all councillors arrange for an annual report to be made available for the meeting.

Playground

Installation of the new equipment commenced on 28th April, projected to be completed early May

The newly planted hedging looks healthy and appears to have rooted however summer watering will be required.

Parkers Pitches completed a weeding, aeration and scarification in March 2025 – depending on the results of this work there may be merit in considering additional treatments in the Autumn.
