I am writing to confirm receipt of Drinkstone Parish Council's Precept Upon the Charging Authority with a precept for 2026/27 of £11,336.

This will be paid to the Parish in two instalments, 50% in April 2026 and 50% in September 2026.

This precept gives the Parish a Council Tax Band D amount of £38.76. This is an increase of 4.31% on 2025/26. These are the amounts that will be shown on the Council Tax Bill.
